

Care and support when you need it most

The Haven Service is available seven days a week, providing day and evening care from 8am to 10pm and night care from 10pm to 8am.

Our aim is to make sure you have the health and social care that you need so you can remain at home. We do this by working closely with your community nursing team, GP, hospital team and other professionals who are involved in your care.

How we can help

- We provide social and personal care support including help with washing and dressing, preparing your meals and giving your carer a short break.
- We provide nursing care so that you are as comfortable as possible in your home.
- We can also provide practical advice, and emotional or psychological support, to help reduce stress and anxiety for you and the person caring for you.

How our service works

Referral to our service is made by the healthcare professional responsible for your care, such as your community nurse, hospice nurse or Macmillan nurse.

Our service is delivered by a team of senior care workers, care support workers and healthcare assistants.

The care you need is coordinated and planned by our registered nurses who are skilled in caring for people who are seriously ill.

The length and number of visits, and the professional who will provide your care, will be arranged according to the support that you and your carer need.

Do I need to pay?

No – The Haven Service is completely free of charge to patients and their families.
